
# Logistics Mission




- Ensure tactical flexibility and mobility through sound logistics planning

# Aviation Logistics



Support of US Air Force, US Navy, US Army, US Coast Guard, USSOUTHCOM, and US Customs Service aircraft

## *Assets supported*

- Airborne early warning: Navy E-2, Customs P-3 AEW, Air Force E-3
- Tracking: Customs and Navy P-3, Coast Guard HU-25
- Maritime patrol: Navy P-3, Coast Guard C-130
- Reconnaissance: Army ARL

# Theater Airlift



## *Oversight of and assistance with routine and emergent requirements*

- Collect requirements from TACON assets
- Validate requirements
- Input requirements into JOPES and other systems
- Monitor missions on Single Mobility System (SMS)
- Conduct 100 missions annually

*Six professional, forward-deployed tactical logisticians coordinate comprehensive CD logistic support*

- “Critical logistic enablers” (Joint Pub 4.0)
- Bilingual ability; understand customs and cultures
- Hands-on support of day-to-day planning and ops
- Support DAO, MILGP commander, Country Team

# Contract Administration



*Administration and oversight for contracts with 25 companies worth \$17M annually*

- Labor contracts (non-personal services)
- Maintenance contracts
- Equipment and supply support contracts

# Contractor and Reimbursable Positions



*Currently 106 contractor personnel onboard*

- 69 perform permanent and interim staff functions
- 6 perform logistics functions in Central and South America
- 31 perform facility maintenance and security functions

## *Reimbursable positions*

- 1 performs base ops support from NAS Key West

# Security Contract



## *Security service contract*

- 1983 - Guard service through NAS Key West
- 1998 - Replaced by DoD security police and active duty (Title 10 USC)
- JIATF continued contracted service
- Exception to Title 10 USC granted by SOUTHCOM

# Contracts Procedures



## *Current procedures*

- Manage 35 active contracts
- Initiate, develop and execute all phases of contract except award
- External contract vehicles currently award actual contract (GSA, NAFKW, etc.)
- Received Contracting Warrants in Oct 02
- Within 6 months, begin in-house contract awards vice using external contract vehicles


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## *Advantages of warranted contracting office*







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# Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection



## *Master plan and project*

- Personnel and vehicle access control and safe stand-off distance around JIATF East compound
- Electronic surveillance and monitoring of compound perimeter and facilities, includes JSSROC and NSA Project FLAMINGO
- Warehouse at remote site
- Aesthetically pleasing design using landscaping in lieu of traditional barriers
